Since research shows that students who do not read over the summer lose on average two months of progress with reading comprehension, S-VE has adopted a summer reading philosophy that all students read during the summer months. 15 percent of your first marking period grade in English 9 will be based on the completion and assessment of your outside summer reading. All incoming freshmen are reading two texts, one already given, Gene Yang Dragon Hoops and one of choice. The chosen text can be selected through OverDrive from our school library webpage at <http://svcsd.org/hslibrary.cfm>. Once there, select WEB OPAC and Databases. At that screen, select OverDrive. Students use the same login as if they were at school.
